



## Graffiti Eater Fabric

### DESCRIPTION

Graffiti Eater Fabric is a graffiti removal solvent used to remove graffiti from fabrics and carpet. The product also performs well removing oil, grease and chewing gum residue.

### APPLICATION

Graffiti Eater Fabric should be used neat as supplied. Apply by applicator brush or spray bottle. Allow Graffiti Eater Fabric to remain on the surface for 5 to 10 seconds, then agitate using either a cloth or a toothbrush (depending on the substrate). Neutralise Graffiti Eater Fabric by using Graffiti Eater Neutraliser chemical to prevent further chemical reactions. Repeat the process until the stain is removed.

### OH&S

Ensure adequate ventilation during use. Wear Type A full face organic vapour respirator in confined areas. (Ref. Australian Standard 1715 - 1991). Avoid contact with skin and eyes, wear eye protection, Vitron or PVA gloves and solvent resistant overalls during use.
